Paul Kuerzi, President-elect of the St. Anthony's Hospice Board of Directors introduced Mark Chumbler, the Executive Director.

Mark introduced six staff members ("angels") of the Hospice and shared the goals of the organization with us. St. Anthony's is currently serving 22% of the non-trauma deaths in our County and would like to be at 33% (60 patients per day) in one year and 40% in 3 years (72 patients per day).

Mark encouraged all Rotarians to do the following four things:

1. Talk about St. Anthony's Hospice and help spread the word "When our friends die may not be a choice; How they live is."
2. Share your personal stories at Hospice with them.
3. Send your sympathy donations to St. Anthony's when designated.
4. Buy hoedown tickets!
