Congressman Ed Whitfield brought greetings to Rotarians and expressed his gratitude for this district allowing him to serve as Congressman. He commented on the loss of jobs over the past 5 years, but noted that in our district even though 8,000 jobs were lost, 19,000 new jobs were created through 54 new plants and expansions. He also remarked about the price of gasoline and what is being done about that issue. He stated that there are presently 98 ethanol plants in operation and 34 new ones are under construction.
